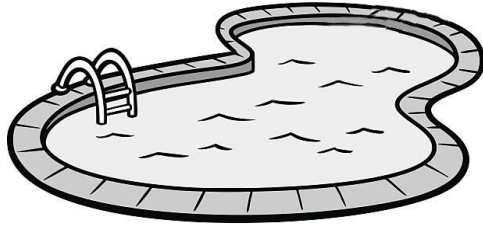

POOL NEWS

We want to formally thank our C.W. lifeguards and CWHA Pool Managers. These individuals have been managing unique challenges to ensure that our pool is open as often as possible. Our city and our nation are struggling to find available lifeguards. Our CWHA Board voted to raise our lifeguard wages to keep and reward the guards we have on our staff. Although our pool has been forced to remain closed on some days, our staffing situation looks to improve with multiple guards being able to return to work for the month of July. Thank you, Canterbury Woods, for your ongoing patience and understanding.

Staffing has not been our only issue at the pool. With the staffing shortage, many CWHA Board members have helped by checking member tags at the pool gate or volunteering around the pool. Our Pool Managers spend hours every day ensuring that our pool operates up to code and is safe for all to use. Our lifeguards and Pool Managers have had issues with individuals arguing or simply not following the rules. The rules are established to keep our community safe and liability-free, to keep our staff members safe, and to ensure that our pool will be able to operate for years to come. Moving forward, if a Board member needs to come to the pool to enforce pool rules, the offending household and all associated pool tags will receive a formal warning. If the offending household receives a second removal from the pool, its pool tags will be suspended for the remainder of the year.

Remember that all guests are the responsibility of the CWHA member bringing the guest to the pool.
